Dear Team Members, Residents and Families,

Bellaire at Stone Port remains focused on the welfare, safety, and health of our residents. We appreciate the efforts and support from everyone involved during this unprecedented time. We continue to follow guidance from CDC as well as from our local health department, the Virginia Department of Health (VDH).

This letter is to alert you that we were notified that one of our team members has tested positive for COVID-19. These team members function in varying capacities here at Bellaire at Stone Port. This team member was asymptomatic, and the results were reported to us from the lab who conducted our first round of testing. This team member, in addition to all team members, was wearing masks and continues to wear masks during all resident interactions. We have been in communication with VDH and as a result of all team members wearing masks, the VDH has advised that exposure would be considered low risk.

We continue to screen residents and team members daily for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. At this time, we currently do not have any residents with positive COVID-19 results.

All of team members continue to follow the CDC's recommendations to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. We recently had an infection prevention assessment conducted by VDH to ensure that we're following infection control practices.

We will continue to allow outside patio visits that will need to be scheduled with the concierge. We understand that connecting with family members is important. Other ways to connect include telephone, email, virtual meetings, Facebook and Facetime. Please let us know how we can assist you.
