Greetings,

This letter is to inform you that yesterday evening one of our residents tested positive for COVID-19 using the Rapid Antigen Test. This resident was tested because she was displaying some symptoms. The family member of this resident has been notified.

The COVID-positive resident is being isolated to her apartment and contact and droplet precautions have been initiated. Team members who enter the apartment will be limited and will be required to wear full PPE to limit exposure.

Our resident population is 100% vaccinated. All unvaccinated team members will be tested using the rapid antigen test.

In the meantime, we have reached out to the Department of Health for guidance and reported the positive case to the Virginia Department of Social Services. Our protocol may change as we continue to get guidance from the Virginia Department of Health.

- We continue to require all team members to wear face masks at all times, and practice appropriate social distancing and hand-washing practices.
- At this time, visitation procedures will not change. We ask that visitors wear masks when entering the community. Vaccinated visitors may remove masks when in the vaccinated resident's apartment.
- Visitors are asked not to attend group activities or communal dining.
