Dear Residents, Families and Team Members of Bellaire at Stone Port,

Due to the rising number of positive team members that work with our Assisted Living population we have been directed by the Virginia Department of Health to halt all visitation, group activities, and communal dining for our assisted living residents in addition to our memory care neighborhood. We have conducted a round of testing today in Assisted Living which concluded with no positive residents. We will continue to quarantine Assisted Living residents in their apartments until the next round of testing in 3 days, which will be Friday, January 28, 2022. We will know more about when the quarantine will end following the round of testing on Friday. We will continue to monitor all residents for signs or symptoms daily and will test residents with symptoms if they arise.

For our Memory Care community, we are also continuing to restrict visitation, activities, and communal dining. We will test all negative residents again on Thursday, January 27, 2022. We will continue to quarantine our Memory Care neighborhood until we have concluded 2 weeks with no additional positive residents.

Thank you for your patience and understanding. We will continue to communicate any updates or changes to each of our residents, their families and team members. Please reach out to me with any questions or concerns.
